

An ordinance to lay out and open Hillcrest Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Allendale.

1. A public street shall be laid out and opened in the Borough of Allendale from Myrtle Avenue at point of intersection of lands of David Mowerson to Hillcrest Avenue of the width of fifty feet being twenty-five feet on each side of the following described lines:

Beginning at an iron bolt on the center line of Myrtle Avenue said bolt being distant 1,095.87 feet northerly along the center line of Myrtle Avenue from a stone monument at its intersection with the center line of West Allendale Avenue, and running from thence (1) on a true bearing of North 28-14 East, across lands of Yeomans and Alling, 637.38 feet to a point on the center line of lands of the North Jersey Rapid Transit Company, thence (2) North 22-56 East across lands of Tallman, 482.20 feet to a point on the southerly line of lands of one Ivers where the same is intersected by the division line between lands of the said Tallman and lands of one Alling, and there to end.

The above described line being the center line of a fifty (50) foot street, that is to say, twenty-five (25) feet lying on either side thereof.

2. The said public street shall be known and designated as Hillcrest Avenue.

3. The council do hereby determine to take and appropriate such lands and real estate as may be necessary to be taken and appropriated for the laying out and opening of said public street upon making compensation to the owners by purchase thereof at a price to be agreed upon, and if an agreement as to compensation cannot be made by the payment of damages.

4. The damages and benefits resulting from the laying out and opening said street shall be duly assessed upon the property affected by the laying out and opening of said street.

5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
