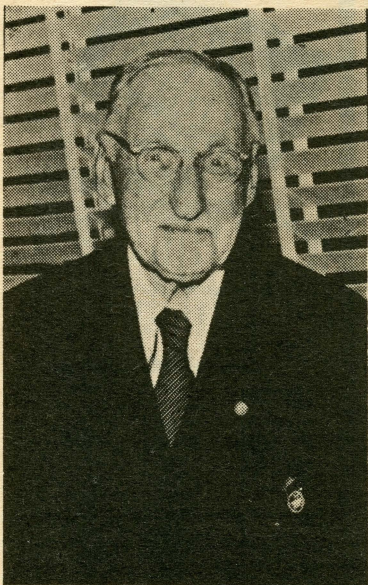


Dr. Pittis, 88, Party Guest

ALLENDALE -- A birthday celebration was held last Thursday in the home of Mrs. Georgiana Parlman, 234 Brookside Ave., in honor of Dr. Godfrey Pittis of 185 Myrtle Ave. Dr. Pittis, born in Plainfield in 1874, celebrated his eighty-eighth birthday anniversary and marked his sixty-second year in Allendale.

Dr. Pittis came to Allendale and purchased the office and home of a doctor who was retiring, and began his practice on Franklin Tpke. This residence is now used by Dr. Leo P. Schultz.

Dr. Pittis attended Dartmouth Medical School in Hanover, N.H. After graduating from Dartmouth he went to Willard State Hospital on Lake Seneca, N. Y. for internship.

After serving near Coney Island with the Emergency League during the First World War, the doctor was married to Mrs. Maude Grey in 1918. Mrs. Pittis had been active in Brooklyn affairs and continued her activities in Allendale until her death. The couple moved to the Myrtle Ave. home in 1922.

After World War I Dr. Pittis became active in developing realty in Allendale and surrounding areas.

Since 1900 when he joined Fidelity Lodge in Ridgewood he has been an active Mason. He was coroneted a thirty-third degree Mason seven years ago. As recently as the end of June, Dr. Pittis attended a masonic convention in Miami, Fla.
