(about - 3 mi) - Watchung Ave - to Grove St. Montclair


(about - 2 mi) - Grove St. - to Bloomfield Ave. - Montclair

name to Elm St.)

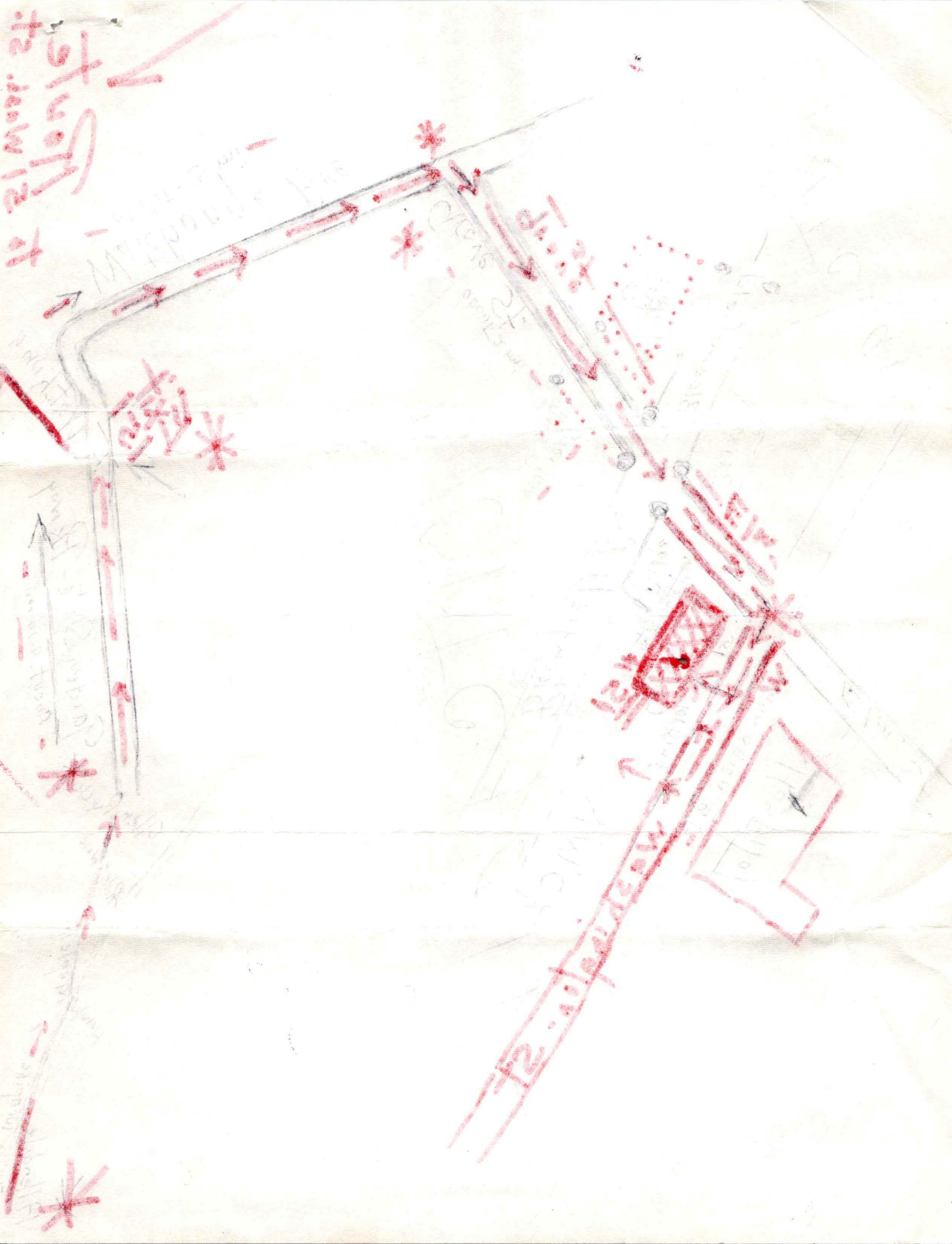
and go 1 Block on Elm St. -

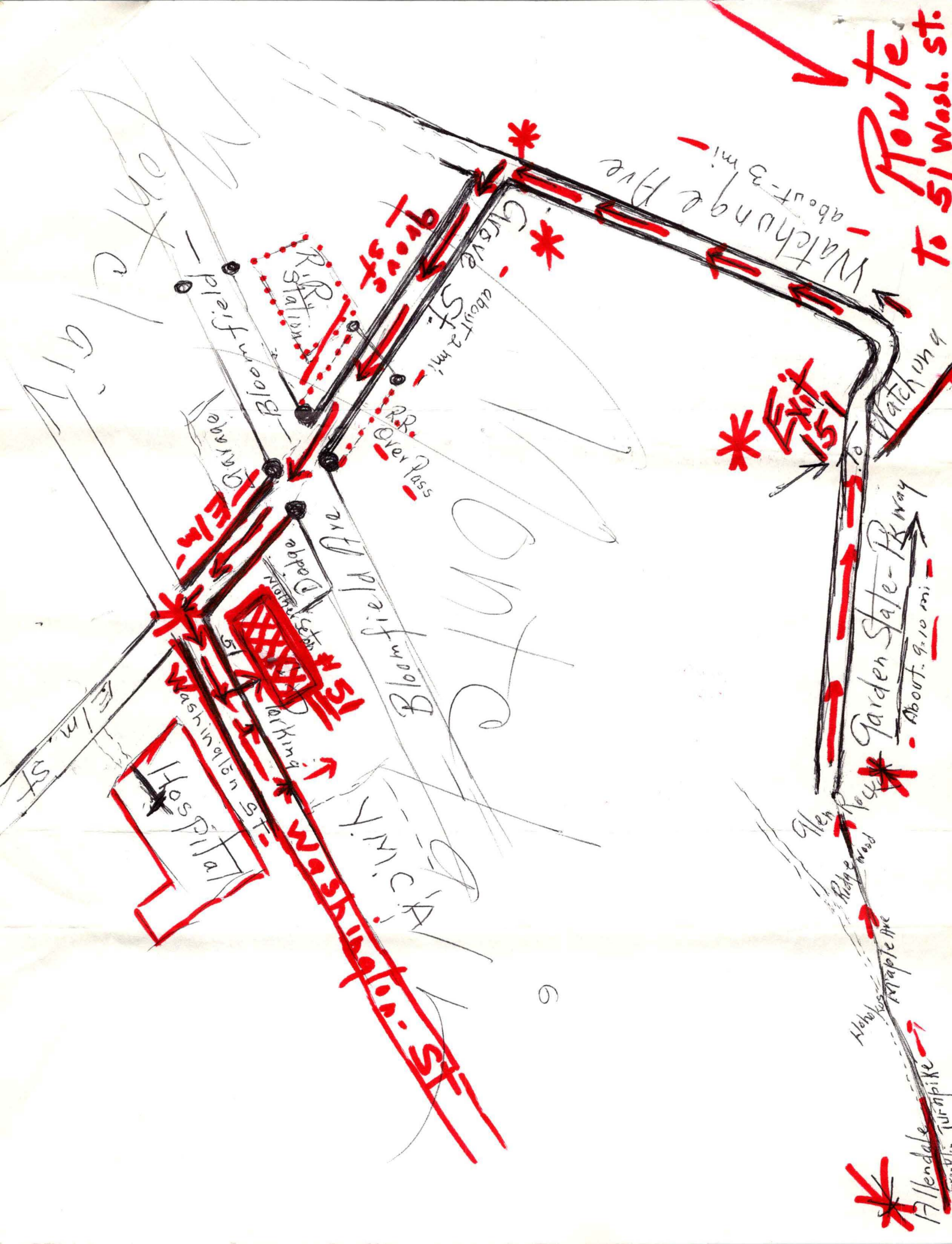
to Washington St. - Turn left
