J. W. Allen was one of the engineers who laid out the Paterson & Ramapo R. R.

Date of Franklin Tkp. is doubtful. It must have been named when William Franklin was governor and he was arrested in 1776. The Demarest Inn (later Mt. Prospect) was authorized in 1756. In 1797 Dobbin & Tustin of Goshen were given stage coach franchise, New York to Goshen.

Winter, one of the prominent families. House at 62 Elm St. Garret Hopper Winter ca. 1866 married Charity Ann Dater, dau. of Abraham Dater of Saddle River. Property on Elm belonged to another dau. Jemima whom we used to visit when I was a youngster. The sons of this Winter ran the hardware store for many years.
