As part of the "Libraries '76" Bicentennial Celebration, the Mid-Bergen Federation of Public Libraries has published New Jersey, its Earliest Settlement to 1783: A Bibliography.

This bibliography was prepared by the reference librarians of the member libraries of the Mid-Bergen Federation and represents a fair survey of the combined collections. Final editing and compilation was done by Alfred Giraldi, Johnson Free Public Library, Hackensack, while typing and collation was completed by the staff of the Bergenfield Free Public Library.

The over four hundred entries are grouped by subject and arranged alphabetically by author except for the county and municipal histories which are arranged by jurisdiction. Being book oriented, the bibliography excludes pamphlets, periodicals, and non-print material. Also excluded are items from two research collections located at the Johnson Free Public Library; the Bergen County Historical Society Collection and the Microfilmed Manuscript Collection.

The Historical Society's Deposit Collection comprised of books, periodicals, clippings and documents is especially strong in local histories and genealogies. The Manuscript on Microfilm Collection which was prepared by the Hackensack-Ridgewood Local History Service, consists of microfilms of primary manuscript documents. This collection affords convenient access to source materials in the area of New Jersey and local history.
