Abraham Quackenbush enlisted as a private in the 2nd Regiment, Orange County Militia, during the Revolutionary War.

Abraham's will (Bergen Co. B:110) dated 16 Nov 1816, pr. 22 Jan 1817, described him as of Franklin Township. In the will he left bequests to sons Abraham and John (also named executors) and to (deceased) son Leonard's children: Crisy Quackenbush ("now wife of John Remar"), Rynard Quackenbush, Sally Quackenbush, and Mary Ann Quackenbush, "to share and share alike as they reach the age of 21."

They are listed in the 1850 Federal Census, living

in the Allendale area. He is listed as a farmer, with real estate valued at \$4,000. This Abraham probably lived in the house at 700 Franklin Turnpike, Allendale, built about 1824. He owned a large farm in this vicinity and his sons built homes there: Abraham at 555 Franklin Turnpike; Corines at 754 Franklin Turnpike; and Martin at 184 Myrtle Avenue, all in Allendale.

Abraham was probably related to the Abraham A. Quackenbush who signed, Jan. 1811, Road Return (D:239), Franklin Twp., petition for road vacation of "The Shunpike."

His will was dated 21 Jan 1871, pr. 15 Apr 1880 Bergen Co., NJ

Cornelius H. Quackenbush was a house painter. He was one of Allendale's first elected councilmen in Dec 1894. He was a charter member of the Allendale Fire Association in 1910.

He was living with his parents at the time of the 1895 State Census. In June 1905 living with him were Margaret Quackenbush, b. Apr 1827, widow; and Gladys G. Strong, b. Feb 1883 NY, single, a housekeeper. Living with his family at the time of the 1910 Federal Census was Gladys Strong, housekeeper, 26, single, b. NY. In January 1920, living with him was an aunt, Hattie D. Franklin, 63, single, b. NY.
